Title: Prevention of dropouts in DK

In most European countries there is a heavy focus on the importance of education from the perspective of the individual as well as from society's point of view. Many programmes and actions have been undertaken in pursuit of increasing the level of education and prevent the amount of dropouts. Despite this, many young people are not able to meet the educational challenges and demands of society. This year's Academia programme in Denmark will focus on the backgrounds and reasons for young people dropping out from education and training and various initiatives and projects established to prevent this. The programme will also deal with guidance of young adults with special needs for counselling and guidance as well as with problems relating to dropouts.

Purpose

- * to provide an overview of the Danish guidance system
- * to provide the participants with knowledge and inspiration concerning different initiatives towards dropouts in upper secondary school, vocational training and higher education
- * exchange of experiences among the participants – including initiatives towards dropouts
- * to provide a forum for further networking

Content

The participants will get an overall presentation of the Danish guidance system and the system for education and training. The focus of the week will be on the role of guidance and the possibilities of intervention to prevent students from dropping out of a chosen education or training. An issue for discussion will be the ethic dimensions of different interventions.

The one-week programme will include lectures, study-visits at schools and university colleges, discussions and exchange of experiences between the participants.

Title: Complementing toolbox of methods in LIFELONG GUIDANCE

Purpose

The objective of the ACADEMIA exchange 2014 is to offer a possibility for guidance practitioners to complement their tool-box of methods and exchange information on lifelong guidance, education and labour market in Europe.

Content

The participants will get an overall presentation on the Estonian lifelong guidance system and services, current situation in the field of education and labour market. The conclusions and evaluation of the programme about the study visit will be collected at the end of the week.

A one-week programme will include lectures, site-visits, professional meetings, workshops, discussions and sharing experience between the participants.
